

After evading capture for years Belinda Bookie walked right into a sting operation and has been arrested. She has been wanted for running a vicious underground gambling ring in the Southeast that has led to several people being injured. Belinda was arrested upon going to pick up what she believed to be coveted tickets to the University of Alabama vs. Auburn University football game. Belinda is currently in police custody awaiting a hearing, said Sheriff Williams.

Bethany Bookie, Belinda's younger sister alerted police three weeks ago after becoming suspicious of all the mail that Belinda was getting. The letter is signed from Buford Justice, the President of the Charter Club of Lee County. When asked about the Charter Club Justice said that it is a service organization yet they do not actually do much service. He also said that he was asked to send out this letter to a select few by Sheriff Williams. Justice and Williams were working on a project together but Williams will not reveal any information related to the tickets that Belinda thought she was receiving.

The long awaited arrest is a "mix of emotions," said Sheriff Williams. "The police force really came together to make the arrest."
